Lyonville Community Planning Update

It's been a year since our Community Plan, developed in consultation with the Lyonville community, was presented to Council. Since then, Lyonville Community Planning Group Inc has been established as a not-for-profit incorporated association so that we can open a bank account and apply for grants, and three working groups have been set up to address different areas of the plan. Although it may seem that not much has happened in the past year, a small group of dedicated volunteers have been working in the background to try to implement some of our goals. Here's an update of where we are in carrying out the plan:

Planning, Infrastructure & Services Working Group

The first action of this group has been to try to improve road safety on the main road and within the township. Dialogue with Council, Regional Roads Victoria and the Police has commenced but the process is slow. The group will also be working on improving communications and power supply services in future.

History, Art & Culture Working Group

This group has been exploring ways to enhance commemoration of the 50th anniversary of the Lyon-ville Woodchop in 2023. It has also been helping the Hall Committee with preparations for a mural to be painted on the corrugated iron fence at the hall.

Lyonville Look & Feel Working Group This group has been working on ways to enhance the look and feel of the township eg. by improving street tree landscapes, improving township signage, and liaising with Council and VicTrack to turn part of the unused railway land into fenced parkland. The group has recently been successful in securing a Council grant to develop an Open Gardens of Lyonville event in 2023 - more on this later in the newsletter.

We need you We could do much more if we had more people able to participate. The plan has many goals that were suggested by our community and if we want to realise them, we need more hands. In a post-COVID world, it's finally time to resume our life in the community. Involvement in the working groups is a worthwhile step to getting back into our lovely community. Hall Committee Update



The Hall Committee is pleased to announce that Telstra mobile phone reception at the hall has been greatly improved following the installation of a booster on the roof. This will allow us to trial EFTPOS facilities at the café and events in future.

The Committee has applied for a State Government grant to install a generator to help the community when we have lengthy power outages. We hope to hear the result of our application soon.

The project to construct a roof near the pizza oven progresses slowly and once we have detailed building plans we can apply for a building permit. We have replaced and improved external lighting at the hall to facilitate outdoor evening events.

Our thanks to Jason Boston for his excellent efforts as café coordinator over the last few years and a big welcome to Gillian Howard who has assumed the coordinator role. We would welcome more café volunteers — both cake bakers and baristas — so the roster is easier for all and so that for those who are not confident bakers we can get additional supplies on their Sundays. We may be securing a piano for the hall soon—watch this space...

Garden Club and Open Garden Day

The Lyonville Garden club has been snoozing during COVID but it's time to meet again, especially as we now have an Open Garden Day to plan for 2023! The first meeting will be **Sunday 30 October at 10am** at the Café de Lyonville. We will discuss activities for coming months and also plan for the insurance lyong Carden Day.
